

Family Membership 2013

BDCC is an adult club but wishes to promote a family friendly policy in order to encourage young paddlers. The club recognises it does not provide young person facilities and requires the parents or guardians to supervise all activities.

A family is defined as one or two adults living at the same address and ANY biological child or legal ward (foster child, step child etc.) not necessarily at the same address.

Family membership is equivalent to two adult rate. I.e. £110 (plus any joining fee) at current rates. In this case ALL members of the family as defined above are considered members and as such are covered by the club insurance and pay member rate for all pool sessions.

As a further dispensation. Any single parent member or country members, wishing to bring their children at an infrequent rate, as judged by the committee, then the following applies. Children of 12 years old and younger will pay a members rate for the pool, but remain as temporary members for the pool session only. Children of 13 years and older must either join the club or pay full non-member rate.

Adults are 16 years and older. At all times Children remain the responsibility of the Adult member. Country Membership is at the sole discretion of the committee.
